Tips For Writing Your Letter

- It's good to begin with a generic greeting: "Dear Hero" or "Dear Troops".
- Be creative! Be personal!
- Have your child draw a picture.
- Share something about yourself.
- Use kind and encouraging language to support them.

Here are some examples:

"We care about you."

"Thank you for protecting our country!"

"Thank you for your bravery and dedication."

"My best wishes are with you"

"I'm truly thankful for what you have done."

- You may choose to include your address or email address, if you would like to. They might write back to you!
