



## Tom Green County Library Launchpad Tablets Usage Policy and Agreement

Our Library System is proud to present Launchpad tablets for children!

Launchpad tablets are pre-loaded with reading & educational apps, videos, and storybooks. They do not have Internet access. Launchpad tablets are intended for guided learning, and adult supervision is recommended.

North Branch and West Branch have a selection of tablets that can be signed out for use inside the library. These "In-House" tablets are clearly marked and must remain inside the library.

A separate collection of Launchpad tablets may be checked out from the library branches and taken home. They **may only be checked out to an adult with his/her library card**, and the account must be in good standing. There is a limit of 1 tablet per family.

The tablet kit contains 1 plastic case, the tablet, and a charging cord.

### **User Agreement**

I understand that the tablet **checkout length is 2 weeks**. The checkout may be renewed if there is no waiting list. I understand that I must return the tablet kit altogether, in-person, to the library staff. Launchpads may **NOT** be returned through any bookdrop. **There will be a \$10.00 charge for violations.**

If I lose or damage the device while it is in my care, I am responsible for the replacement costs: \$5 USB charging cord. **Total of replacement charge is \$169.99.**

I understand that failure to comply with this Tom Green County Library Launchpad Tablet Policy may result in suspension of privileges at all member libraries.
